

## Application Guidelines for Exchange Students to Ochanomizu University (Fiscal Year 2023)

### A. Educational Characteristics

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Application Requirement	• Applicants should be female or women identified students only. *For those whose gender identity differs from the record on their family register or passport, we can provide, in advance, information and guidance regarding the use of rooms, etc. to help you after the semester begins. For more details, please contact us 《ryunai@cc.ocha.ac.jp》. • Exchange students are expected to have the Japanese language capability necessary to participate in lectures, seminars and tutorials at Ochanomizu University. • Exchange students should return and graduate from the home university after their period of study/research at Ochanomizu University.

Application for Exchange Students (Form 1) • Recommendation Letter (Form 2) • Study/research plan (Form 3) • Photocopy of Passport (ID page) • Academic transcript • A photo (40mm×30mm) with no background for Application for Certificate of Eligibility • Japanese-Language Proficiency Test Certificate of Result and Scores ( if applicable) *Health Certificate is not required
Selection and Notification	The result of selection will be sent to a partner university in around two months after each application deadline.

Language of Instruction	Japanese
Number of Required Classes	Minimum: 8 classes per week (includes Japanese language classes)
Credit System	Based on a credit unit system
Grading System	Your academic achievements are evaluated by S, A, B, C or D grades although S is applicable only to the Undergraduate Courses not to the Graduate Courses. Grade of “S” is given for excellent performance, “A” for good performance, “B” is for above average, “C” for average and “D” for failure.

Language Classes (Open to Exchange Students)	The Japanese language classes are optional. There are two classes, “Seminar: Japanese” and “Seminar: Japanese Culture”, each of which corresponds to 2 credits and is offered at 5 different levels from beginning to advance. There are also Tokusetsu Nihongo (literally translated as “Special Japanese”) classes, such as “Introductory Japanese”, “Intermediate Japanese”, “Advanced Japanese”, “Advanced Japanese Reading”, “Advanced Japanese Writing”, “Chinese Character”, and “Japanese Language Proficiency Test”. Students will be advised to take classes based on the result of a placement test at the beginning of the semester.

## E. Scholarship

Scholarships for exchange students under inter -university exchange agreements are very limited, so they are expected to support themselves while the stay in Japan.

## F. Accommodations

A new dormitory opened inside the campus in April 2022. All the rooms are single and furnished with a bed, a shower room, a toilet, a desk, a fridge, an air conditioner, etc. Laundry machines are mutual facilities. It is self catering and the cost of meals differs individually.

Costs:

Entrance fee: 48,800 yen

Monthly cost : 59,800 yen

(Including room rent fee, residents’ association fee, internet fee, insurance fee, and utilities except for gas.)
