

# Learning Mandarin in Taiwan

#### **Nandarin Chinese Teachers & Teaching Assistants**

The MOE provides subsidies to send trained Mandarin Chinese teaching personnel overseas. Educational institutions that want to employ teachers of Mandarin Chinese and teaching assistants can contact an overseas mission or embassy of the R.O.C. (Taiwan) for details.

#### **IDENTIFY and SET UP:** Training for Overseas Mandarin Chinese Teachers

The MOE provides subsidies of NT\$2,000 per person per day for groups of overseas teachers of Mandarin Chinese to come to Taiwan for up to two weeks, for further professional training.

#### **Foreign Student Short-term Mandarin Chinese Study Groups**

The MOE provides subsidies of NT\$6,000 per person per week for groups of foreign students to study Mandarin Chinese in Taiwan for 2–4 weeks.

#### Huayu Enrichment Scholarships:

#### for foreign students to learn Mandarin in Taiwan

- · Monthly stipend: NT\$25,000.
- · Duration: 2, 3, 6, 9 or 12 months.
- Eligibility: Foreign students at least 18 years old who have graduated from secondary school, have excellent recent academic results, and are of good character.

#### **IDENTIFY Taiwan Huayu BEST Program**

The MOE subsidizes universities in Taiwan to collaborate with foreign universities to promote Mandarin Chinese learning. Benefits for the overseas partner university include having teachers & teaching assistants from Taiwan, scholarships for students to learn Mandarin Chinese in Taiwan, and access to a wide variety of learning resources.
