The Austrian Embassy would like to inform that the OeAD, Austria's Agency for Education and Internationalisation, announced that for the academic year 2024/25 scholarships will again be made available for foreign students, graduates and scientists.

Detailed information on hundreds of scholarships can be found on the Austrian Database for Scholarships and Research Funding www.grants.at (available languages: German and English). In addition to the scholarships provided by the Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research, this database also contains information on many scholarship programmes of other institutions.

The following scholarship programmes could be of particular interest to you:

- Franz Werfel Scholarship - Target countries: worldwide
Franz Werfel Grant is intended for persons with above-average qualifications, preferably with teaching experience and employment at a university, who focus on Austrian literature. The duration of the scholarship is four to nine months; an extension to up to 18 months is possible. Persons who consumed at least 12 scholarship months can apply for the follow-up support programme.
- Ernst Mach Scholarship worldwide - Target countries: worldwide
The Ernst Mach Grant – worldwide invites applications from PhD students, postgraduates, postdocs and young lecturers from universities outside of Austria. Students and academic teaching staff from all fields of study can apply for a grant period of 1 to 9 months, extensions are not possible.
- Ernst Mach Scholarship to study at an Austrian university of applied sciences - Target countries: non-European countries (and Ukraine)

Undergraduate and graduate students from non-European countries (conducting a degree Bachelor or Master level) can apply for the Ernst Mach Grant for Studying at an Austrian university of applied sciences, which allows research visits of 4 to 10 months at an Austrian university of applied sciences. Extensions are not possible.

- Ernst Mach Scholarship ASEA UNINET - Target countries: Indonesia, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam

Applications are open to postgraduates with a master degree (including master thesis), and postdocs with a doctoral degree (or equivalent) in various fields (including Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts), as well as to Undergraduates and Graduates in the field of music practice (only). Currently, applications from ASEA-UNINET member universities in Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam are accepted. Depending on their type, the grants are awarded for up to 9 months to up to 36 months.
