## ◆Eligibility requirements

Students who are enrolled in our partner universities, ISEP Exchange or UMAP Program A universities and were nominated by the home institution.

Students whose G.P.A. is 2.5/4.0 or higher [Partner University], 3.0/4.0 or higher [ISEP/UMAP].

Students who have a Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) score of N3 or higher or the equivalent of CEFR B2 or higher in English or who come from a university where the language of instruction is Japanese or English.

If you do not submit the documents by the deadline, we will take that to mean that you have declined the placement and withdrawn your application.
