

**Announcement from the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration
Chiang Mai University**

**Scholarships for Undergraduate Students for the First Semester of Academic Year 2025
Type: Educational Support Scholarship (Second Round for First-Year Students)**

The Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration has allocated funds from its income budget and has also received scholarship donations from foundations, associations, and individuals. These funds are intended to be distributed as scholarships for students within the faculty who are in need of financial assistance to support their education.

Accordingly, the faculty is now accepting applications from undergraduate students who wish to apply for the **Educational Support Scholarship** for the first semester of the academic year 2025, under the following criteria:

1. Eligibility Requirements

- 1.1 Must be a first-year undergraduate student enrolled in the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration and registered for the first semester of the academic year 2025.
- 1.2 Must be financially disadvantaged and in genuine need of educational support.
- 1.3 Must demonstrate **good behavior** and must **not have been subject to any disciplinary actions**.

2. Required Supporting Documents

- 2.1 A completed scholarship application form (12 pages)
- 2.2 The following items must be uploaded within the application form:
 - 2.2.1 A photograph of the student in university uniform (1 photo)
 - 2.2.2 Three photos of the student's permanent residence:
 - Photo 1: Close-up of the house showing the house number
 - Photo 2: Close-up showing the entire house
 - Photo 3: Wide shot of the front of the house including surrounding areas, carport, sky, and ground

Note: All photos must be signed and certified at the bottom-right corner (front side) by the village headman, subdistrict chief, or a government officer of at least level 5 or equivalent, to confirm that the residence belongs to the student.
 - 2.2.3 A hand-drawn **map showing the route** from the student's house to the main road or national highway, clearly indicating directions and kilometer markers.
- 2.3 An official **family income certification**, with a copy of the government officer's ID card. For executives from private institutions, a copy of their national ID card with "certified true copy" must be attached.

3. Application Procedures

3.1 Complete the scholarship application and screening form for Semester 1/2025 via the website <http://sis.cmu.ac.th> using your CMU IT Account from now until June 30, 2025.

3.2 Print the completed form and all supporting documents (as listed in 3.1), **scan all 12 pages**, and email them to: **sunthari.t@cmu.ac.th**, including:

3.2.1 Certified income verification document (Page 8), with a copy of the certifying officer's ID (for government officials) or national ID (for private executives), both marked "certified true copy"

3.2.2 Certified advisor recommendation form (Page 9)

3.3 Submit the printed documents in person to the **Educational Services and Student Quality Development Office**, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, **by July 14, 2025**, during official working hours only.

3.4 Applicants who submit the complete application and confirm their information in the system within the deadline will be screened and verified by the Faculty.

4. Announcement of Interview Candidates


The list of students eligible for interviews will be announced by **July 21, 2025**, on the website www.pol.cmu.ac.th.
