#### **Application Procedure**

Application documents should be sent to the Directorate for Internationalization of Education Universitas Indonesia. The office will deliver the application to the related faculty where the application will be reviewed. Upon approval from the faculty, we will issue admission packets to students. We will serve as their point of contact during their stay once students arrive at the university.

- Student should make contact with the office at their university or host to manage exchange program.
- Student must seek advice and approval from home university to join our exchange program.
- Nominated student must complete the UI Student Exchange application form.
- Student must submit the complete application form and supporting documents to the Directorate for Internationalization of Education Universitas Indonesia.
- Following receipt of students' application, we will seek approval for the requested study program from relevant faculty. Once it has been approved by the related faculty, an acceptance letter will be issued to the student.
