

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “MOU”) is entered into by and between Asia Centre, address 128/183, Phayathai Plaza Building, 17th Fl., Phayathai Rd., Thung Phayathai Ratchathewi, Bangkok 10400, Thailand, (hereinafter referred to as “The Centre”), and the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, Chiang Mai University, address 239 Huaykaew, Muang, Chiang Mai, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as “CMU”).

The two parties agreed to develop academic collaboration as follows:

1. The parties, based upon the principle of respect for each other’s independence and of mutual benefit, desire to collaborate in the following activities:

- a. Exchange of staff, professors, and research scholars
- b. Exchange of scientific material, publications, and information
- c. Joint research and other activities within the range of interest of both organizations
- d. Co-host an International Conference

2. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOU will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the parties, and in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval. It is understood that the implementation of any type of cooperation stated in the previous clause may be restricted depending upon the availability of resources and financial support at the organizations concerned.

3. In witness whereof, the parties to this MOU through their duly authorized representatives have executed this MOU on the days and dates set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to this MOU as set forth herein.

This MOU shall be effective from the date of signature for three (3) years and may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated at the request if either Party. In this case, six (6) months of written notice must be given.
